- Wednesday, May 15, 2024 between 7:30-9:00 AM Collect samples and drop off at Albemarle County Office Building- 1600 5th Street Ext, Charlottesville, VA 22902. Samples are sent to Virginia Tech for analysis.
- 3. Results will be emailed (mailed if email not provided) in approximately 30 days. An online presentation link will also be provided to help you understand your results.
