## **2024 Northern Shenandoah Valley Drinking Water Testing Clinics**

Do you have a well, spring, or cistern?

Learn about your water quality through affordable, confidential testing and become empowered to make decisions about system maintenance and water treatment!

The goal of the Virginia Household Water Quality Program is to improve the water quality and health of Virginians with private water supplies, including wells, springs, and cisterns.

### How does it work?

- 1. Pick up a sample kit at the designated location for your county.
- 2. Participate in the Kick-Off Session In-person or via Zoom. If you can't attend, please plan to watch the instruction video (5 minutes) when you come to pick up your kit.
- 3. Collect samples on the designated date and drop them off at the designated location for your county.
- 4. Samples are analyzed at Virginia Tech.
- 5. Participate in an in-person Results Meeting to help you understand your results. You will receive your confidential results at the meeting.

How much does it cost? \$70 per sample kit.
