

**Do you have a well, spring or cistern?**

**Learn about your water quality through affordable, confidential testing and become empowered to make decisions about system maintenance and water treatment!**

***The goal of the Virginia Household Water Quality Program is to improve the water quality and health of Virginians with private water supplies, including wells, springs and cisterns.***

**How does it work?**

1. Pick up your sample kit at the local Extension office with physical distancing measures or request to receive it by mail. We will be offering a **drive-through pick up** at the Brambleton Center between **4-6:30pm on Mon, 8/17/2020**.
2. Collect samples on **Wednesday, 8/19/2020** and drop off locally at the Brambleton Center (drive through drop off) between **7:30 and 9:00am**.
3. Samples are analyzed at Virginia Tech.



Receive your confidential results, an explanation of what they mean, and information about addressing any problems via email. A recorded video presentation will be available to help you understand your results.

**What does the water test include?**
