- Pick up your sample kit at the local Extension office with physical distancing measures or request to receive it by mail. We will be offering a drive-through pick up at the Brambleton Center between 4-6:30pm on Mon, 8/17/2020.
- Collect samples on Wednesday, 8/19/2020 and drop off locally at the Brambleton Center (drive through drop off) between 7:30 and 9:00am.

 Samples are analyzed at Virginia Tech. Receive your confidential results, an explanation of



what they mean, and information about addressing any problems via email. A recorded video presentation will be available to help you understand your results.
