Do you have a well, spring, or cistern?

Learn about your water quality through affordable, confidential testing and become empowered to make decisions about system maintenance and water treatment!

The goal of the Virginia Household Water Quality Program is to improve the water quality and health of Virginians with private water supplies, including wells, springs, and cisterns.

How does it work?

1. Pick up a sample kit at the designated location for your county.
2. Participate in the live Kick-Off Session via Zoom.
3. Collect samples on designated date, and drop them off at the designated location for your county.
4. Samples are analyzed at Virginia Tech.
5. Participate in the in-person Results Meeting to help you understand your results. At the meeting, you will receive your confidential results and information about addressing any problems.



What does the water test include?

How much does it cost? \$60 per sample kit. **Financial Scholarships Available:** Cost reduction to \$10 per sample kit is available for those who have an annual household income of \$50,000 or less.
